## GENERAL BUSINESS:

1. Women's Trials. All pairs available . David Anderson said he would use all scores to determine an average.
2. Seniors Trials. Entry Form was tabled.
3. Gold Cup. Entry Forms were sent to all clubs.
4. Appeals Panel. Gordon Fallon has offered to organise an appeals panel when required. There is a Notice on the SABF Noticeboard to this effect. Players have been approached and a list of names of those willing to be on the Panel will be given to the Director.

5. Psyche register .

It was recommended that SABF Regulations be changed to introduce a Protected Pairs status to align with the ABF regulation 2.9 Protected Pairs. Pairs playing a Green system without the use of Brown sticker Conventions will be granted protected pairs status where both players are below the status of National Master, or one player is below the status of Local Master. Clubs to be notified players will be required to use a Convention Card with a green sticker together with an orange sticker.

Protected Pairs status will not be allowed in State events.

Suggested definition of Psyche Bid "Gross misstatement of strength , length or values."
